# Gram Panchayat Public Schools



- The Office of District Collector, Ramanagara, had requested companies located in Harohalli and Bidadi Industrial area to take-up a project of constructing Gram Panchayat Public Schools for nearby village students. Accordingly the Company has taken up construction of a school at Bannikuppe, Ramanagara District.
- Currently the students are facing problems at schools such as insufficient teaching and training rooms, absence of laboratories and well-equipped libraries, limited playgrounds and sports equipment, and a rising number of student dropouts, lack of subject wise teachers. There is a growing demand from children and parents for education in the English medium.



# Gram Panchayat Public Schools



- At Bannikuppe the Company will construct a well-equipped school building with strong infrastructure and other facilities namely administrative block, academic block, counselling block, health centre, playgrounds, sports equipment, well-equipped library and laboratory (science, mathematics, and language labs), hobby centre, computer education, smart classrooms, etc. The schools would be equipped with kitchen and dining area, access to clean drinking water, and modern cooking equipment to ensure the health and well-being of the students.
- The school building will have capacity to accommodate around 800 to 900 students, The estimated construction cost would be around ₹4.5 crore and ₹5 crore and expected to be completed in 30 to 36 months.

- Construction of school will be considered as Ongoing project and will be dealt as per applicable provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 and the Rules made there under.
