- NAPS (National Apprentices Promotion Scheme) is launched by Mınıstry of Skill Development & Entrepreneurship & NATS (National Apprentices Training Scheme) is launched by Ministry of Human Resource Development.
- Organization having more than 30 employees has to employ minimum of 2.5% of total employees as Apprentices under NAPS or and NATS.
- Organization can employ maximum of 15% of total employees as Apprentices.
- Difference between actual and minimum apprentices can be claimed under CSR.

#### **Current Status:**

- SKL has registered itself for NAPS & will register for NATS in a weeks time.
- Currently we have 60 apprentices in the month of Oct 2022.
